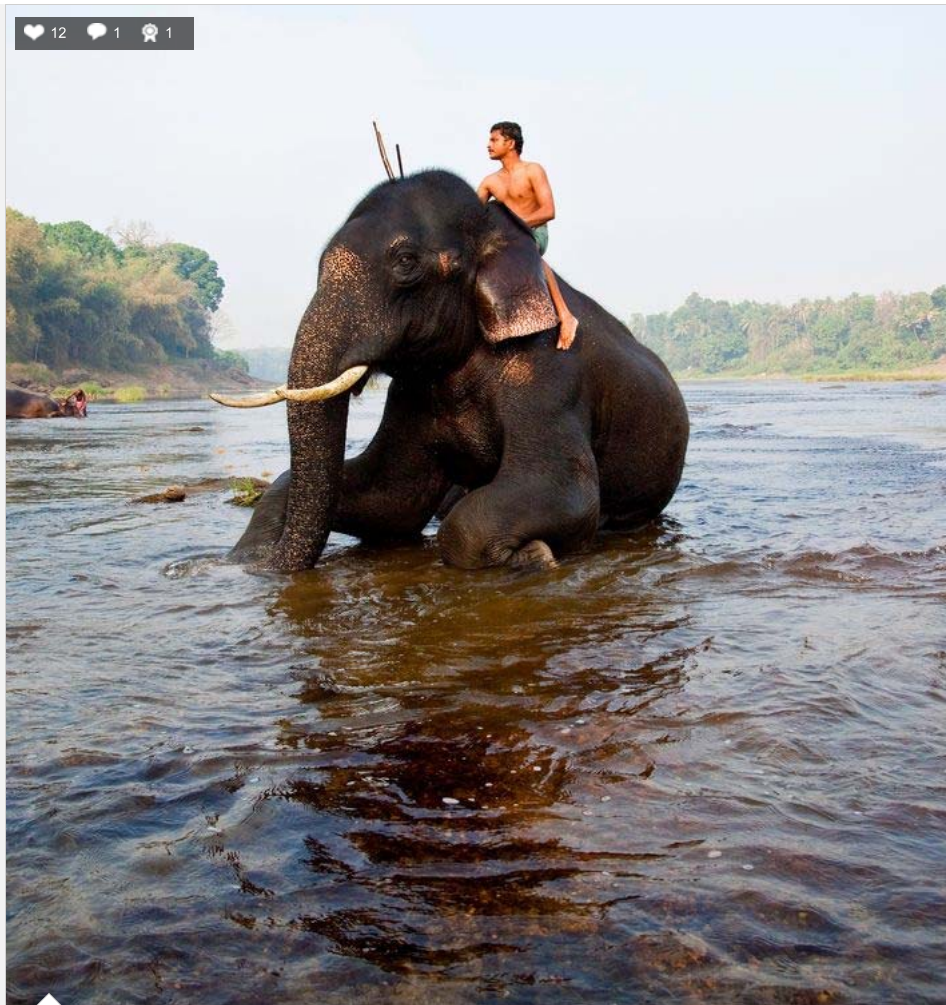
Malaysia

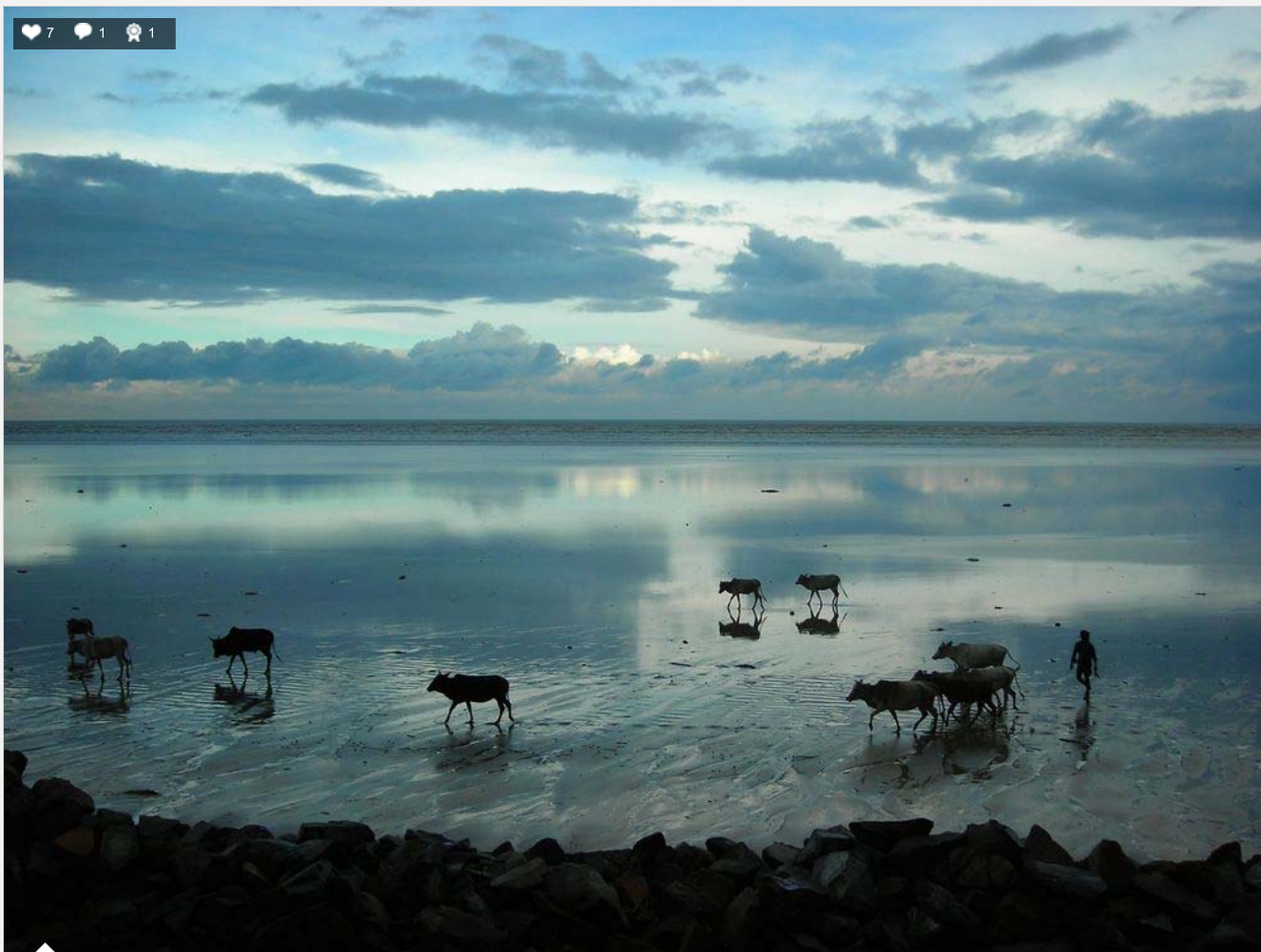

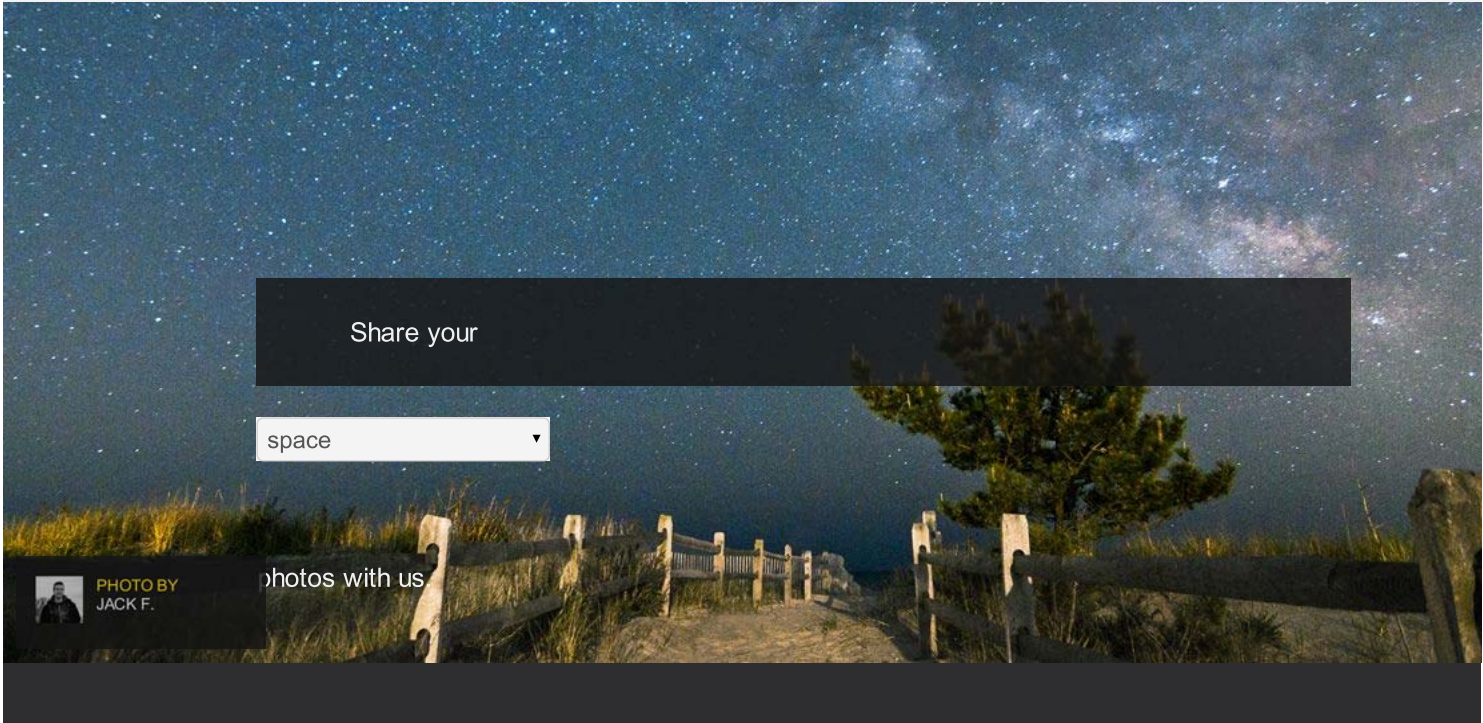
